#### I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Sjostrom called the meeting to order at 8:06 a.m.

#### II. ROLL CALL

Six council members were present, and a quorum was established. Joining the meeting later were Superintendent Hanna and Mr. O'Bryant.

#### III. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Ms. Green requested the Consent Agenda Rule of Order under Executive Director's report be removed from the agenda, as it was not necessary for action. Ms. Cummings moved to approve the agenda as amended; Mr. Mitchell seconded the motion. It was unanimously approved.

#### IV. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM APRIL 21, 2022, MEETING

Mr. Mitchell moved to accept the minutes from the April 21 meeting, as presented. Dr. Glenn seconded the motion; minutes were unanimously approved.

#### V. GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

#### VI. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Ms. Green advised that a consent agenda could be used for non-controversial items starting with the June Governing Council meeting. Prior to the consent agenda being approved, a Council Member or staff can request an item be pulled either for discussion at the current or future meeting, or because it is not relevant. Ms. Green presented the latest budget development and TRIM schedule for FY 2022-23, confirming the next meeting date for the Finance and Budget Committee, confirming the members. Commissioner Cummings advised she would not be in attendance.

General Counsel Christopher Roe presented Resolution 2022-05 to approve the final lease agreement and designation of rental payments for two years for the identified CSC Leon office space. Mr. Mitchell asked that the lease agreement language be clarified so that the space can be used by members of the community outside of normal business hours. Counsel agreed, and Mr. Mitchell subsequently moved to approve the resolution. Ms. Cummings seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.

Ms. Green advised that a draft of the final needs assessment would be provided on May 31 at the Program Services Committee meeting and that a workshop is scheduled at 1:00 p.m. prior to the June 16 Governing Council meeting, and that a "provider roundtable" at which the final needs assessment would be discussed is tentatively scheduled for July 28.

#### VII. Committees & Reports

#### A. Treasurer's Report

Mr. Mitchell presented the financial reports. Ms. Cummings moved to approve the reports as presented; Dr. Glenn seconded the motion. The reports were unanimously approved.

#### **B.** Program Services Committee Report

Dr. Glenn provided an overview of the Summer 2022 Request for Applications (RFA), noting that 53 applications were submitted totaling approximately \$4.1 million in requested funding. Staff appointed six members to the "Community Impact Panel" to evaluate and score the applications. Ms. Green and Ms. McPhail presented the scoring summary and methodology options for selecting programs to fund.

Dr. Glenn requested an option be created that identified applications scoring in the top 25% of possible scores in at least three of the five categories. Staff prepared and presented the requested methodology.

Ms. Cummings moved to approve funding option 1A. Mr. Watts seconded the motion. The Council accepted public comment as follows prior to taking a vote.

Judge Sjostrom called for a 10-minute recess at 10:15 a.m. The Council reconvened at 10:21 am. Additional public comment was provided from Ms. Patrice Ward.

Chair Sjostrom concluded comments and called for a vote on Ms. Cummings' motion. The motion failed by a 5 to 3 vote. Mr. Mitchell then moved to accept funding option 3d, which was created by request of Dr. Glenn; Mr. Hanna seconded the motion. The motion passed 7 to 1.
